**COMMERCIAL** UNDER CONSTRUCTION



Key West International Airport Concourse A project is advancing remarkably through both day and night shifts. The second-floor slab has been completed and soon we will finish the concrete walls and parapets on the east side as we are erecting the steel structure on the west side. At the same time, we are building two staircases, two elevator shafts, passenger bridge, chiller, and generator platforms, utilities, and MEP. All the available apron panels have been replaced and the roofing and curtain wall installation will begin soon.

# NEW MARKHAM CENTER FOR TEACHING AND LEARNING

Fort Lauderdale, FL

The Center for Progressive Teaching and Learning is a new two-story 19,322 square foot building that replaces the former Stacy Hall Building and becomes the new focal point at the main entrance to the Pine Crest School Fort Lauderdale campus. Features include new covered walkways, a new brick paver courtyard, and a large covered entry complimenting the aesthetics of the existing campus, including exterior red brick work and natural cast stone bands. The interior includes a large two-story volume front entrance lobby, classrooms (including Innovative Lower School I-Labs and Robotics) and a new state of the art interactive library.

We have completed the 2nd floor concrete slab and are presently working on the concrete block walls on the 2nd level. The upcoming phases of work include the setting of the roof truss system, the tile roofing assembly, and an octagon shaped skylight.










COMMERCIAL UNDER CONSTRUCTION



The specialty skate park construction is nearing completion, with all concrete poured and the final railings being installed. Interior work including framing is continuing at the skate park accessory building. Light fixtures are being installed at the airnasium. Sprinkler piping installation has been completed at the airnasium. Stucco work is being installed at the accessory building. The concrete tilt walls have been erected at all buildings for the preschool and the building is being topped off. All structural steel joists have been installed. Precast concrete planks have been installed at the 2-story building. Roofing work has begun at the preschool. Interior mechanical rough-in is starting for all MEP trades.



## MEDICAL CLINIC EXPANSION Hollywood, FL

The medical clinic expansion will add approximately 27,841 square feet of new construction to the existing Medical Building. The addition will contain an imaging center, administration center, educational services, an assembly boardroom, and common seating areas. The building will provide basic civic, administrative, and medical services to the community.



Willis Custom Yachts, located in Martin County on the St. Lucie River, has entrusted Gulf with the expansion of their existing marine facility. This multi-phased project includes sitework development and several different building uses including commercial, retail, restaurant, industrial marine manufacturing, pre-engineered metal buildings, and waterfront work. The new 20,000SF pre-engineered metal building is currently being erected while design of the 40,000SF retail and commercial trades building is underway. All work is being coordinated around existing operations to allow the marina to stay in service throughout construction.



New construction of a one-story, 31,125 square foot Senior Center with the necessary spaces to support active lifestyles and wellness. The center will provide various activities including a multi-purpose room that functions as a dining area as well as an open space for social gatherings and events supported by a raised stage. Additional indoor activities include gym, aerobics, massage room, arts and crafts, theater, computer and reading spaces, and locker rooms with showers and a sauna.



Construction of the new, modern Fire Station No. 113, which more than doubles the size of the old station, is progressing nicely and is on track for an on-time and on-budget delivery in the 1st quarter of 2025. The project was topped-out in April and is currently working to be fully dried-in prior to the rainy season. Things are about to get busy, and we look forward to delivering this important project to the City of Delray Beach.

## NEW MEDICAL CENTER, BEHAVIORAL HEALTH & PUBLIC SAFETY BUILDING Immokalee. FL



The Seminole Tribe of Florida's Immokalee Medical and Behavioral Health Centers and Public Safety Facility are all nearing completion, with an estimated final completion date of mid-May 2024. The Medical and Behavioral Health Buildings are in the final painting and cleaning stages, with owner furniture scheduled for installation in early April. Landscaping and irrigation have been installed, and preparations for the final lift of asphalt are underway.

The Public Safety Facility is also nearing completion, with all systems in place and functional. Final painting is underway, and fire apparatus bay overhead and 'four-fold' doors have been installed. The exterior 8" thick concrete apparatus bay approaches were completed at the end of March. Landscaping and irrigation are underway, and the final lift of asphalt scheduled for mid-April.


